


Project: Conservation and Indigenous Rights to Land in Thailand (<u>link</u>)

In Thailand, IPs rights to LTR has been always violated in the name of development during the nation development and industrial and lately in the name of conservation.


In 2019, the Thai government amended the National Park Act (2019) which fully granted the power to the state authority in control and making decision in this area.


Highest forest area in TH by Pirawan

Key takeaways for applying to my works


